Seed heads in the fairways are finally beginning to slow up and are becoming easier to mow. These seed heads can be an extreme eyesore when the zoysia is flowering and we do our best to keep it at bay. Our scheduled greens applications have been applied along with soil fungicides to keep root diseases at bay during these humid and wet weeks. We aerified greens the last week of May to relieve compaction, allow for oxygen exchange and allow for the drying of the soils to prevent black layer. Fertilizer has also been applied to the fairways, rough and tees along with a second round of fungicide for disease. The weather seems to be improving in the upcoming weeks of June and we have our fingers crossed for great golf weather. We apologize for falling behind due to weather but look to get caught up and provide great playing conditions for all the summer months.
