These past few months have been extremely wet but with mild temperatures. It seems the first part of July will start off with a bang of hot temperatures and dry weather. This will affect the cool season turf around the course and in areas where irrigation is not present. Our greens have been holding up very well to these wet and dry conditions and we will continue to monitor them throughout the upcoming months ahead. As far as projects go, we are finished with our berm on hole 16 to divert water away from the fairway and green. The amount of topsoil pulled off property from hole 15 will save the club an estimated value of around \$3,000 dollars. We will use this dirt for future projects around the course and unsightly areas. We plan to divert water left of hole 14 and remove the native area around the green making all the rough the same height once we are completed. We will pencil tine greens after the Club Championship to let them breathe and apply a light topdressing to smooth out any imperfections.
